MIDWEST FOOD BANK SENDS URGENT RELIEF TO HURRICANE DEBBY VICTIMS IN GEORGIA AND FLORIDA

LOCATION, ST_Midwest Food Bank (MFB), in partnership with The Salvation Army, has launched a significant relief effort to support those affected by Hurricane Debby, which recently caused widespread devastation in Georgia and Florida.

Two semi-trailers loaded with essential family food boxes are being dispatched from MFB's Morton facility to Savannah, GA. The first shipment departs today. These food boxes, designed to provide a week's worth of non-perishable food, are critical for families returning to their homes and beginning the process of rebuilding their lives.

Additionally, Midwest Food Bank will dispatch two semi-loads of water. One will come from their Florida division and the other from their Georgia division, both heading to The Salvation Army's operations near Tampa, Florida.

"Our collaboration with The Salvation Army enhances our ability to deliver much-needed aid to those impacted by this disaster," said Lisa Martin, Executive Director at Midwest Food Bank. "We are delivering these essential supplies to those who need them most, helping families regain a sense of normalcy as they return to their communities."
