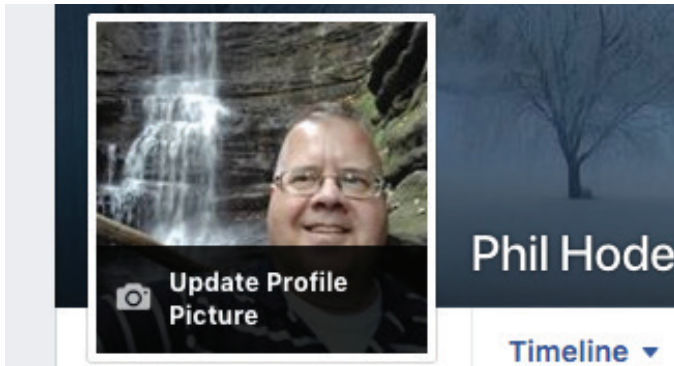


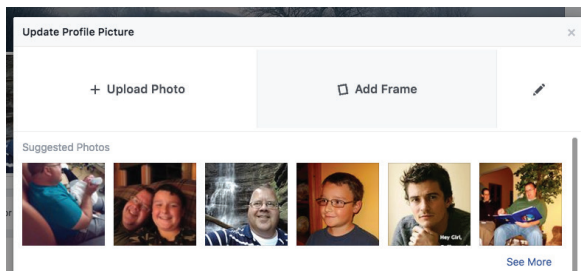
Framing your profile picture

Follow these steps to create a frame for your Facebook profile photo.

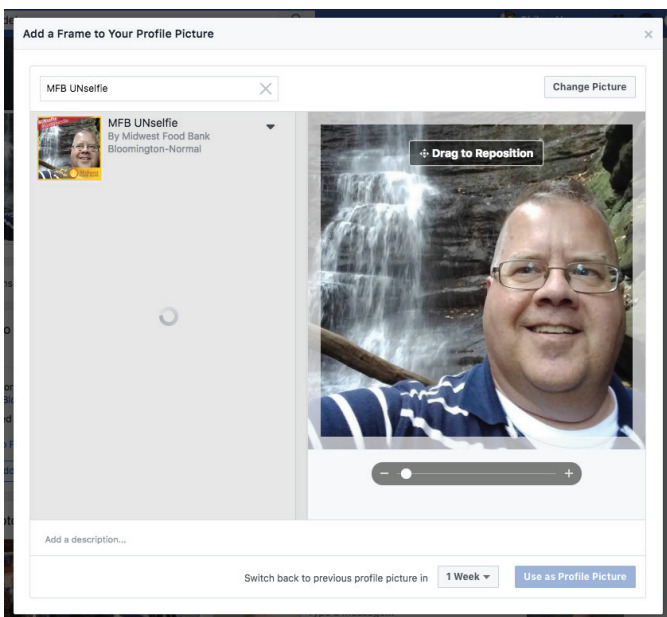
1. When you are on your Facebook page, hover over your profile picture. "Update profile picture" will appear. Click on it.



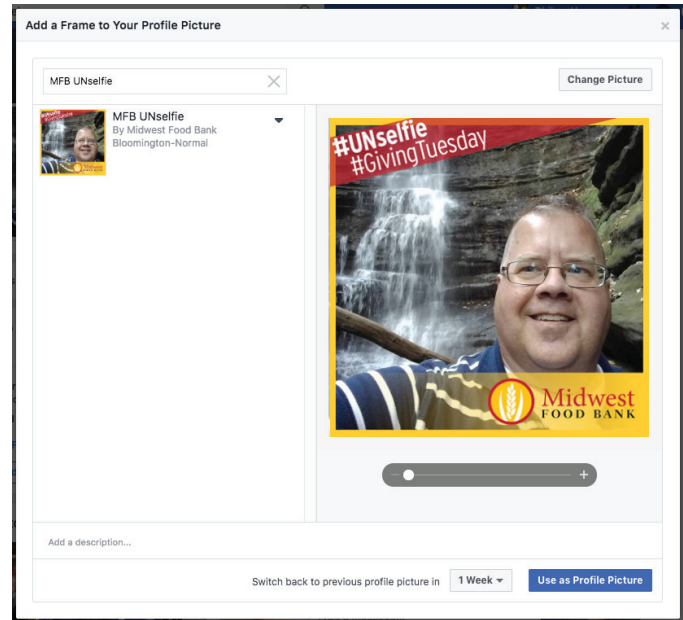
2. This will bring up a menu of options. Click on "Add Frame."



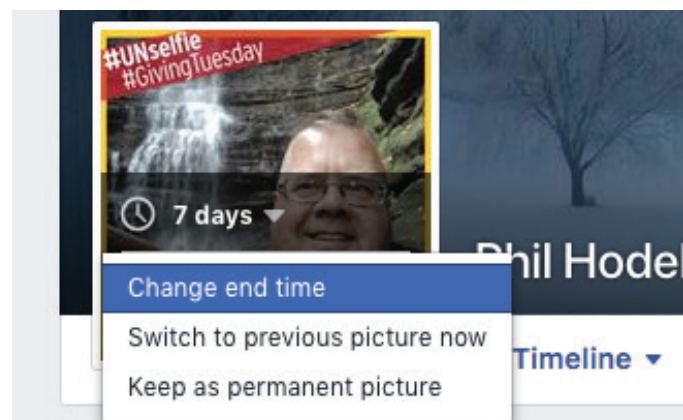
3. In the search bar, type "MFB UNselfie," and select the option that appears.



4. The UNselfie frame will appear over your profile picture. You may drag your photo to reposition it within the frame, or use the bar at the bottom to zoom in or out. When you are satisfied with the positioning, click "Use as Profile Picture" in the bottom right. You should get a message that says "Your Profile Picture was Successfully Modified."



5. The frame is automatically set for 7 days. To change the end date, Hover over your newly framed profile picture. If you click on "7 days," the option to "Change End Time" will appear. Click on it to set a specific time for the frame to be removed from your profile photo (#GvingTuesday is Tuesday, November 27.).



It's a great way to let your friends know about #GivingTuesday and how you are participating.
