Midwest Food Bank Pennsylvania is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that rescues food that might otherwise end up in a landfill. We serve 200 nonprofit agency partners from our Middletown warehouse. MFB food is provided free of charge to qualifying agencies with feeding programs.

We have our own fleet of trucks, including 53' semi-trailers. We can pick up product by the truckload (preferable) and the pallet, depending on the distance.

Our location has a cooler and freezer providing capacity for refrigerated (perishable) and frozen food.
